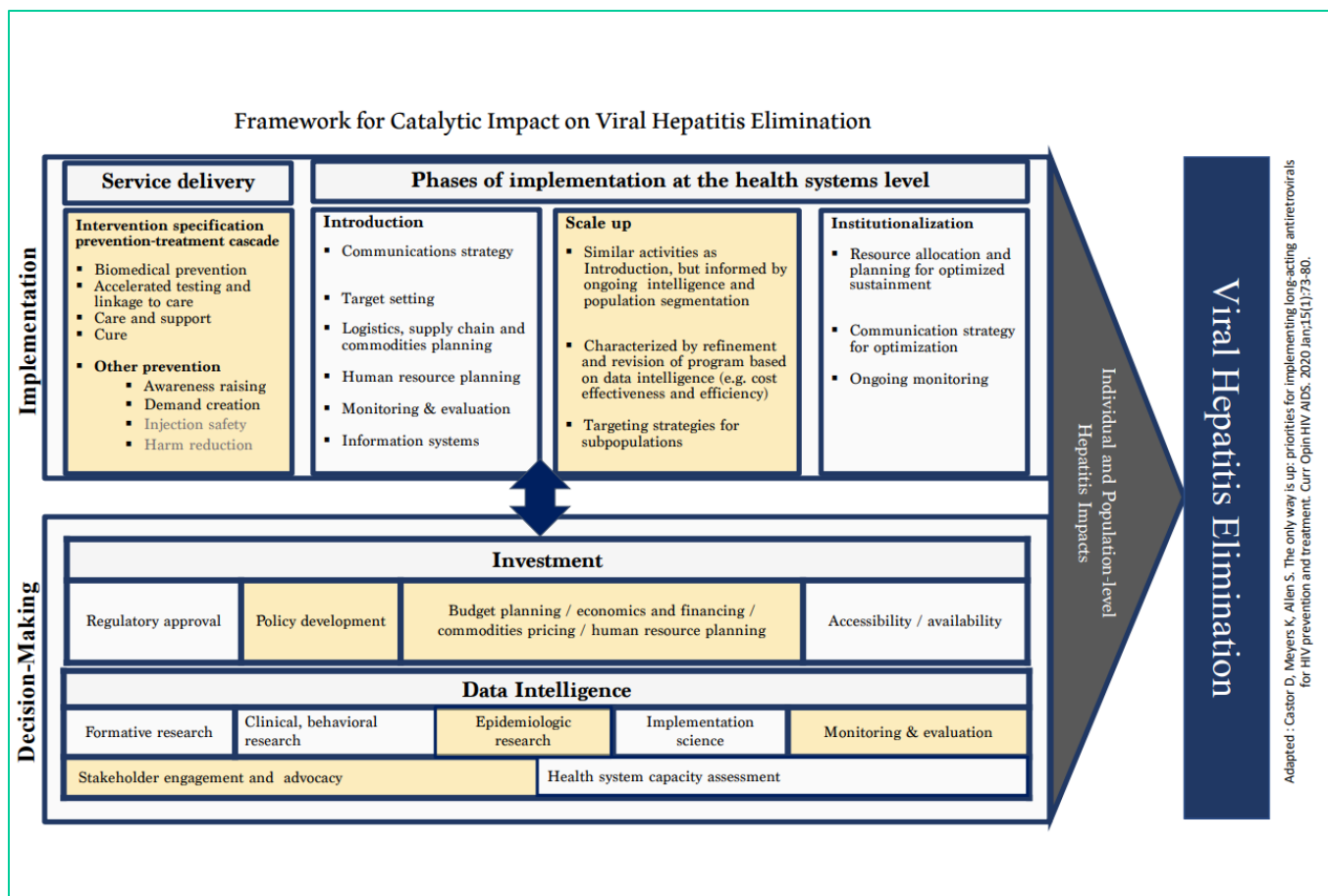


The Hepatitis Fund Monitoring and Evaluation Framework



To measure the catalytic impact of our philanthropic investment, we have developed a unique and cohesive Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) framework. It enables real-time learning so that grantees can correct course and implement their programmes nimbly. Our M&E framework is a tool for systematically monitoring funded projects for catalytic impact, and at the same creating a community of learning and sharing for capacity building.

The framework was elaborated to serve as an overall rubric for evaluating the portfolio as a whole and to allow for customisation of relevant projects in order to assess the process and impact of the catalytic funding. It defines common denominators for assessing process, deliverables and catalytic impact. It's a cohesive and consistent M&E approach that helps define and measure catalytic programme inputs, outputs and outcomes.

It enables real-time learning and timely adjustment to mitigate the impact of force majeure events, such as disruptions brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. Lessons learned and information accumulated will be valuable contributions to the hepatitis community for the global campaign to eliminate viral hepatitis as a major threat to public health.
